Japanese Assistance for New Classrooms at Shree Praja Pragati Basic School in Makwanpur District

(Kathmandu: 1st October, 2019): The Deputy Chief of Mission, Mr. Yuzo Yoshioka, today signed a grant contract for building new classrooms with the Shree Praja Pragati Basic School in Makwanpur District. The construction is expected to cost about of NPR 9.2 million.

The project is funded under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) of the Government of Japan.

At the signing ceremony, Mr. Yoshioka said he hoped that the project could contribute to improve the educational environment of the Raksirang Rural Municipality where the school is located.

More than 50 percent of students attending the school are from the Chepang community, and others are from other indigenous communities. The project is expected to support better education for children of communities that have not had enough educational facilities.

The Embassy of Japan expects the project to contribute towards enhancing the friendship between the peoples of Japan and Nepal.
