Japan Appoints Mr. TOMITA "Japanese Cuisine Goodwill Ambassador"

(Kathmandu, February 14): H.E. Mr. Masamichi SAIGO, Ambassador of Japan to Nepal, handed over an appointment certificate to Mr. Kensei TOMITA, who was designated as "Japanese Cuisine Goodwill Ambassador" by Japan's Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) in December 2019.

Mr. TOMITA opened the Japanese restaurant "Kotetsu" in April 2006 in Kathmandu, and has been serving delicious Japanese food ever since for Nepali people and foreigners in here.
