Important Notice on Re-entry into Japan
for Border Security Measures
to prevent the spread of Novel Coronavirus

On 17 September 2021, the Government of Japan has decided to allow the re-entry into Japan from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, India, Maldives, **Nepal** and Sri Lanka as follows;

The re-entry into Japan of foreign nationals with status of residence who have stayed in aforementioned countries within 14 days prior to the application for landing will be permitted again from 0:00am (JST) on September 20, 2021.

(Note) With regard to the new entry of foreign nationals from aforementioned countries, those who are acknowledged to have special exceptional circumstances by Japanese authorities may enter Japan even if they have stayed in those countries within 14 days prior to the application for landing into Japan. Those foreign nationals have a visa issued by Japanese overseas establishments.
